EMERGENCY EVACUATION PROCEDURES

Fire Alarm Bells warn you a fire alarm condition exists on your floor and you should evacuate:

Tower Levels 8 - 19: All occupants are to evacuate down two (2) floors by way of the nearest stairs to an area where bells are not ringing

Network Levels 1-5: All occupants are to move to the outside by the closest exit

Fire Alarm Chimes alert you a fire alarm condition exists on another floor. You should be prepared for the possibility of evacuation. In the event of an actual fire requiring your evacuation, the BELLS on all floors will be activated or instruction will be given by fire or security personnel.

**IN CASE OF A FIRE ALARM
DO NOT USE THE ELEVATOR.
USE THE STAIRS ONLY.**

- R. Remove all occupants from fire and smoke.
- A. Alarm by activating the fire alarm pull station and calling 333 to notify University Police of the emergency.
- C. Confine by closing all doors and windows.
- E. Extinguish or evacuate. Only use an extinguisher if you can do so safely.
