



N95 Respirator Information

Every department must keep N95 respirators stocked for staff use.

N95 Respirators can be ordered through Lawson:

- 3M 1860S (small) N95 #24815
- 3M 1860 (regular) N95 #21723
- Inovel/Moldex 1510 (extra-small) N95 #51154
- Inovel/Moldex 1511 (small) N95 #26414
- Inovel/Moldex 1512 (medium) N95 #26416
- Inovel/Moldex 1513 (large) N95 #26415

Special N95 Respirators: If an employee cannot be properly fitted with a N95 respirator that the hospital stocks (3M 1860 or Inovel/Moldex 1500) then EH&S will try fitting with alternate N95 respirators. EH&S will provide employee with one that fits and purchasing information for their supervisor. Special respirators can be purchased from Masks N' More (www.masksnmore.com or 405.340.8669) or a similar vendor.

Frequency of Fit Testing:

- Employees who have gained or lost 15 lbs, have experienced change in physical condition that could affect their current respirator fit such as facial scarring, dental changes, cosmetic surgery need to be re-fit tested.
- Employees with direct patient contact and has been identified in the hospital's respiratory protection program, must be fit tested annually.
- Monthly fit testing schedule is posted on the Hospital weekly email announcements; RSVP through EH&S at 4-6783.

Obsolete Respirators:

Employees who were fitted with these obsolete respirators need to be re-fitted:

- 9970, Racal, or Uvex

Medical Clearance: Prior to attending fit testing/training, you must be medically cleared by Employee Health & Wellness within the past year.
